Teacher Enrichment

Dear Teacher,

Thank you for taking the time to lead kids into amazing God Encounters. You are a crucial part of the ministry that will take place this week.

The following is a brief guide to understanding how to navigate this curriculum.

The lesson portion is written for teacher enrichment. This topic can be a little bit too much for younger kids to comprehend. But you, as the teacher, know your kids and at what level they can comprehend the teaching. It is essential that you take the material and present it at the age level you are teaching.

The goal is to simplify the content without watering it down.

The object lesson supplies will be provided and placed in each room before service. You are welcome to integrate the object lesson at any point during the teaching.

Whiteboard section - You will notice there are words to be written on the whiteboard. On the first night, we will put the negative things you dealt with before Jesus. After explaining that you are a new creation in Christ through what He has done, we will erase the whiteboard and begin to write what we have in Christ. We will leave those words on the whiteboard from night to night. These will reference back to what they have learned previous nights. Our goal is to give the kids a powerful dose of who they are in Christ.

THE NEW CREATION SPEAKS LIFE

The new creation in Christ that you have become has a fantastic superpower. This power will help you, your family, and your friends. This power is very simple to use but challenging to master. It is so powerful that it can cause death and even bring life.

This power is controlled by the words that you speak. What you speak in faith, you will have either good or bad.

Proverbs 18:21 - Death and life are in the power of the tongue. Those who love it will eat of its fruit.

We want to use this power that we have wisely. We want to speak life, not death. Your words will have a huge impact on your life. Since God gave us free will and the ability to choose, that means if we speak bad things about ourselves, we will have those bad things instead of what God wants for us. So we want to speak what God says about us and not just how we feel or how bad things might be.

Think back again to when you became a new creation. You believed that Jesus died for your sins and that He rose again. Then according to Romans 10:10, you said Jesus, you are my savior. You believed, then you spoke. You used this God-given power, resulting in you going from death to life!

2 Corinthians 4:13 - We have the same spirit of faith, so we speak.

When you read what God says about you now that you are a new creation, it is important to believe it AND speak it. When you speak what God says about you, it becomes real to you.

Let's look at an example. Philippians 4:19 says that God will supply all of your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Two Christians, brand new creations in Christ, look at this verse.

One of them says, "That would be nice, but I don't see Him providing anything for me, so that's not for me."

The other one says, "No matter what I see, I believe God's word, and He will provide all that I need."

Which one do you think will see God provide all their needs? The second one.

Both of these people are new creations in Christ. Both have EQUAL access to this promise. Yet only the second one sees it come to pass because of what he believes and speaks.

The enemy will try to convince you to give up what God has given you as a new creation. Our job is to speak what God says about these things, not what the enemy says. Both of them know that whichever one you believe and speak will become your reality.

The enemy says - You are not smart enough. You can't do what God has called you to. God says - 1 Corinthians 2:16b ...But we have the mind of Christ. You are more than able through His Wisdom.

The enemy says - You are broken. You will never be enough. God says - Colossians 2:10 You are complete in Him.

The enemy says - You will never fit in. Nobody really likes you. God says - 1 John 3:1-2 What amazing love the Father has shown us that we are called children of God!

OBJECT LESSON

Supplies: 2 Containers, one with something bad in it and the other full of treasure.

Words are containers carrying either death or life.

Explain that whatever you speak will either produce death or life. Words are like containers. When you speak, you choose what you put inside that container. The proverb we read explains that those who speak will “eat of the fruit” of whatever they say. We want to choose our words wisely. You are either creating a harvest of life or death by what you say.

Write on the whiteboard: Provision, Complete in Him, Mind of Christ.
