Teacher Enrichment

Dear Teacher,

Thank you for taking the time to lead kids into amazing God Encounters. You are a crucial part of the ministry that will take place this week.

The following is a brief guide to understanding how to navigate this curriculum.

The lesson portion is written for teacher enrichment. This topic can be a little bit too much for younger kids to comprehend. But you, as the teacher, know your kids and at what level they can comprehend the teaching. It is essential that you take the material and present it at the age level you are teaching.

The goal is to simplify the content without watering it down.

The object lesson supplies will be provided and placed in each room before service. You are welcome to integrate the object lesson at any point during the teaching.

Whiteboard section - You will notice there are words to be written on the whiteboard. On the first night, we will put the negative things you dealt with before Jesus. After explaining that you are a new creation in Christ through what He has done, we will erase the whiteboard and begin to write what we have In Christ. We will leave those words on the whiteboard from night to night. These will reference back to what they have learned previous nights. Our goal is to give the kids a powerful dose of who they are in Christ.

THE NEW SUPERCHARGED CREATION

The Old Man

The old man was under the law of sin and death. Before Christ, we were sinners. We did not have peace with God, meaning we were enemies with God. We would be apart from God forever because our spirit was sinful. Sin was the separating factor that kept us away from God. We could not be with God because of sin. Not just our actions but because of what sin did to our spirit, the core of who we are.

God is both Love and Just. That means He loves everyone and wants them to be with Him, but He is also just, and His justice will not allow sin into heaven. So He created a plan to save the people of the world using His love without compromising His justice.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

His Son's name is Jesus. Jesus lived a sinless life and gave us THE example we are to follow. He is not just a good example; He is the perfect example. But God didn't stop with Jesus being our example. You see, we didn't just need good teaching. We couldn't go to a service or a workshop to learn our way out of sin. It was already too late. Nothing could be done for that spirit that was in sin. That person had to die. But this is where God's love comes in. He had Jesus take our place. Instead of us dying, Jesus went to the cross and paid the price for our sins. He died in our place. Then three days later, Jesus rose from the dead. This shows that Jesus had paid for our sin. Now the only thing left to do is accept His salvation that He offers.

If you have received Jesus as your savior, You are a new creation in Christ. The old person is gone, and you are a brand-new creation.

2 Corinthians 5:17 - TLB - When someone becomes a Christian, he becomes a brand new person inside. He is not the same anymore. A new life has begun!

When you said, "Jesus, forgive me, and I make you my Lord and Savior." a great trade happened. His blood washed away all your sin. You are no longer a sinner. You can now stand before God as if you had never sinned. That means God can justly say you are welcome into heaven because you no longer are a sinner.

Because the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin, we have the boldness to approach God our Father. (Hebrews 10:19) We have access to Almighty God! The sin that was separating us from Him is gone, and now we can speak to Him directly without fear. We can go to God for whatever we need because we are a NEW CREATION IN CHRIST!

OBJECT LESSON

On the whiteboard, write different sins. Ask kids for examples. Explain how these things are not allowed in God's kingdom. Explain how when we accept Jesus, He doesn't just cover those sins. He completely removes them. Erase the whiteboard as you describe forgiveness.

Explain that we are now clean and holy in God's eyes and write on the whiteboard: Boldness, Access to God, and a New Creation. Explain how the new creation in Christ has access to God. We are His children now. (Hebrews 4:16)
