Teacher Enrichment

Dear Teacher,

Thank you for taking the time to lead kids into amazing God Encounters. You are a crucial part of the ministry that will take place this week.

The following is a brief guide to understanding how to navigate this curriculum.

The lesson portion is written for teacher enrichment. This topic can be a little bit too much for younger kids to comprehend. But you, as the teacher, know your kids and at what level they can comprehend the teaching. It is essential that you take the material and present it at the age level you are teaching.

The goal is to simplify the content without watering it down.

The object lesson supplies will be provided and placed in each room before service. You are welcome to integrate the object lesson at any point during the teaching.

Whiteboard section - You will notice there are words to be written on the whiteboard. On the first night, we will put the negative things you dealt with before Jesus. After explaining that you are a new creation in Christ through what He has done, we will erase the whiteboard and begin to write what we have In Christ. We will leave those words on the whiteboard from night to night. These will reference back to what they have learned previous nights. Our goal is to give the kids a powerful dose of who they are in Christ.

YOU ARE COMPLETE IN HIM

The old man was incomplete. We were looking for fulfillment and satisfaction through things in this world like friends, sports, money, being popular, or sin. Those things may bring temporary happiness but do not fix our need for fulfillment.

The new creation that you are in Christ has been given everything you need for life. Everything that you need is yours. It belongs to you.

Ephesians 1:3 - You have been blessed with EVERY spiritual blessing in Christ.

Through our relationship with Jesus, we have everything that we need. Peter says the same thing a little differently here:

2 Peter 1:3 - AMP - For His divine power has bestowed on us [absolutely] everything necessary for [a dynamic spiritual] life and godliness, through [a]true and personal knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

The new creation doesn't look to people for its satisfaction or fulfillment. It is designed on purpose to be fulfilled and content in the Lord.

Jesus did not leave a single area of your life out. He didn't make the new creation with missing pieces or broken. It is whole and complete as Paul tells us in Colossians:

Colossians 2:10 You are complete in Him, who is the head over all rulers and authority

This is where the question comes in: "If He made me complete and gave me everything I need for life, why don't I feel it? Why don't I see it?"

Because the new creation is your SPIRIT, not your mind. Your spirit is the core of who you are. You are not a mind. You are a spirit. When you heard that Jesus died for your sins and rose from the dead, and you believed it, your faith went to work. You said I know this is the truth, and now I am going to follow His word. Because you used faith, it produced what His word said. You became a new creation in Christ.

The same way that you used your faith and you became a new creation. You must use your faith to see God's promises work for you. When you read His word and say "I don't see that in my life or I don't feel like I am complete in Him" you are causing your faith to stop working.

Romans 10:17 says that faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. When you hear the word your response to it determines if it will work for you or not. The word of God when it is mixed with faith always works.

We must do what Romans 12:2 says. We must renew our minds. Our spirit is perfect and doesn't need any work, but our mind needs God's word and thoughts. Our minds need to line up with what our new creation spirit knows is true.

When we believe and speak His word it will become our reality. We will experience that we are complete in Jesus. We have everything we need for life in Jesus. We are blessed with every spiritual blessing in Jesus.

OBJECT LESSON

Flashlight and wall plug light. One will have power from an outlet and the other from batteries.

Before Christ, you are like the light that needs to be plugged in. You look everywhere for something to fill you up and make you happy. But those things are temporary. You are looking for love to fill you up and keep you full. But when you walk away from that, you feel empty. (Give examples of things people might do to fit in or feel accepted. Explain how those things give temporary happiness, but it is fleeting.)

After you are in Christ, you are like a flashlight. You are no longer looking outside for fulfillment, attention, or love. You are fulfilled on the inside. The new creation will still enjoy compliments or receiving love from other people, but they are not dependent on that for their identity. They continue to shine with or without the affirmation or love of others. They have THE source of love and light inside of them.

Write on the whiteboard: Fulfilled, Loved, Accepted, and Joyful.
