Teacher Enrichment

Dear Teacher,

We will leave those words on the whiteboard from night to night. These will reference back to what they have learned previous nights. Our goal is to give the kids a powerful dose of who they are in Christ.

GOD HAS A GOOD PLAN FOR YOU

Over the last four days, you have learned about what you have in Christ. You are a new creation; you have a new identity. You can learn much more about what you have in Christ. I encourage you to study it more. Find scriptures that tell you what you have in Christ.

Many people are searching everywhere for a sense of purpose and direction for their life. They try all kinds of different destructive things, trying to figure out what they are supposed to do with their life. They were designed with purpose, something that God wants them to do. But if they don't know Jesus, they will not be fulfilled.

However, you are not like them. You have all of these wonderful things in Christ. The power of God is alive in you. You are called a Child of God. What are you supposed to do with the things you have in Him?

Ephesians 2:10 tells us that God has a purpose for your life. He has prepared a plan and a path for your life.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].

He created you for Him to use. Not only did He create you, but He also created a plan for your life! You can see from this verse that His plan for you is to do good works and bless those you are around. He created a path for you to walk down. This path is full of blessings and provision.

God shows us in Jeremiah 29:11 that His plans for us are good. We can trust that where He tells us to go will be the best for our lives. Because He created the plan, we want to listen to what He tells us. David was anointed by God to be king, but the plan took quite a while from when David was anointed and told he was to be king until he was crowned king of Israel. David knew that God had good plans for him, and he wrote this: Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Since God is the one who designed the plan, we need to look into His word to see where to go and how to get there. David calls God's Word a lamp to his feet. It helps him to see what steps to take next. David trusted God even when things were difficult. He refused to turn back and go in a different direction because he knew that God was the one who would lead him in the right direction.

<u>OBJECT LESSON</u>

Supplies: Flashlight. Red and green paper.

Turn the lights off, then shine the flashlight at your feet and explain how the Word of God is like a light for your feet. It shows you the next steps to take and which ones to avoid. We need to read God's Word and listen to His voice to follow His plan for our lives. Place the red and green paper on the floor and have them step on the green paper. Show them how the light makes it easier to tell what is right and wrong.
