David 1 Samuel 17:1-51

Read today's story from the Beginner's Bible

Psalm 24:8 (open hands like a book)



David tried on King Saul's armor. It did not fit.




David was just a boy. He was not scared. David had faith in God.

David took off the armor. He took 5 stones from the river and put them into his sling




David fought Goliath and won. David was little, but God was big.

Cut out shield and paste to a paper plate or card stock. Allow kids to color their shield and attach a pipe cleaner to the back to create a handle for the back of the shield.

Shepherd's Pouch David and Goliath Bible Story

Supplies: copies of pouch and stone templates scissors
 crayons or markers yarn or twine
 hole puncher tape

1. Copy pouch and stones templates onto white or colored card stock for each student and cut out. Each student will need one page of pouch templates and a half page of stone templates. Punch holes through the pouch pieces on the circles along the edges (works best if done with both pieces together so the holes will be exactly aligned).
2. Give each student a piece of yarn or twine approximately 50 inches long. Put a small piece of tape around one end so it will be easier to thread through the holes of the pouch.
3. Have students thread the yarn through the holes along the sides of the pouch, tying off to leave a long strap so that the pouch can be worn as a “cross body” bag.



