GREETER VISION

It is our vision for each child that enters in the Clubhouse to enter an atmosphere where they feel welcome and acknowledged.

GREETER ROLE

Greeters provide the initial positive impression for the kids to build on throughout the service. Greeters will cultivate a space where kids are known and loved as they enter the room. Greeters will be stationed at the door and stay within a very close proximity to the door for remainder of the service. This will help with smoother transition for kids that arrive late to service. This is also necessary to minimize distractions that could occur when entering the room.

Expectations for Greeters are as follows:

- Attend a huddle prior to serving on Sunday.
- Be in the room 10 mins earlier than service begins to greet children.
- Stay within 10 feet of the entrance of the room throughout service.
- Greet kids with a smile and enthusiasm as they approach the room.
- Stop children at the door to ask them if they have gone to the restroom since arriving at Life Church. If they have not been to the rest room send them to the rest room before they enter the room. If they do not have an urge to relieve themselves, at the very least have them wash their hands and go if they get an urge at that point.
- Serve on the A/B team typical room schedule.
- Assist checkout until a child arrives to enter the room for the subsequent service.
