PRAYER

PRAYER OF INTERCESSION

MEMORY VERSE:

Romans 8:26, “...the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.” (NASB)

TAKE HOME POINT:

The prayer of intercession is standing in the gap for someone else.

2. BIBLE TIME

READ:

Genesis 19:1-29

MAIN POINT:

God told Abraham that Sodom and Gomorrah were evil cities and He would bring judgement to the people that lived there. Abraham stood in the gap and pled for the lives of the people.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Who did Abraham stand in the gap for? (cities of Sodom and Gomorrah)
2. Why? (they were evil and God was going to bring judgement)

DISCUSS:

Read 2 Corinthians 4:4

- Satan is the god of this world and has blinded others to God.
- We intercede for others by standing in the gap. When we do, it takes the blinders off of their eyes.
- It is best to intercede for others before we witness to them.

3. FAMILY TIME

READ:

Romans 8:26

MAIN POINT:

The Holy Spirit will help you intercede.

WHAT YOU NEED:

A heavy suitcase.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Ask one of your children to move the suitcase for you.
- Help them move it.

DISCUSS:

- The suitcase was too heavy to move by yourself.
- When you had help it could be moved easily.
- The Holy Spirit helps us when we pray.

SPIRITUAL EXERCISE:

- Make a list of those friends and relatives that are not Christians.
- Intercede for them.
- Do this on a regular basis.
- Ask each one if the Holy Spirit is telling them when to talk to them about salvation.
